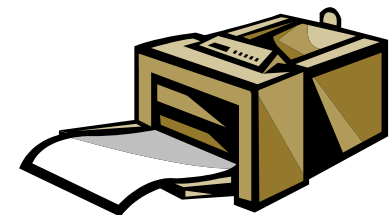

Headstart (St. John's): The government funded program that helps preschoolers begin the transition to the public school system is just one organization that makes its school year home here.
